Day 1

1. Scripture

Read 2 Chronicles 7:1-3 and 7:11-18

2. Reflection

As you reflect on the scripture today, where do you see God calling for repentance?

Where do you see God calling for prayer?

Where do you see God calling Solomon to obey the scriptures, or the Word?

Why do you think God chose the temple as His house of sacrifice?

Read 1 Corinthians 6:19. From what temple does God accept prayer today?

3. Prayer

Start the prayer for this series by dedicating your temple to God

Day 2

1. Scripture

Read Jonah 3:6-10

2. Reflection

What Word of God reached the King of Ninevah?

Why do you think the King covered himself with sackcloth, sat in ashes, and called for a fast throughout Ninevah?

The Ninevites heard the Word, repented, and prayed. When God saw their prayer and fasting what did He do?

Read Matthew 12:41. Why did Jesus tell his hearers that the men of Ninevah would rise up and condemn them?

What Word of God has reached you? What has God called you to repent from?

3. Prayer

Ask God to reveal something to you this morning that you need to repent from. Then commit to Him in prayer your repentance from that area in your life. Ask for the courage to take action today.

Day 3

1. Scripture

Read Ezra 9:5-15

2. Reflection

Where do you see repentance in the scripture today?

Where in the scripture today does Ezra acknowledge the Word of God?

In what posture does Ezra pray?

How does Ezra say God has treated the Israelites? (see verse 13)

3. Prayer

Go to a private place and pray like Ezra did - on your knees with your hands spread out to God. Thank God for His mercy in your life and pray that He would keep you from falling into sin.

Day 4

1. Scripture

Read 2 Chronicles 34:8-21

2. Reflection

In what state is the temple in the beginning of the passage, and where was the Bible?

What effect did reading the Bible have on those who heard it for the first time?

Where do you see prayer in the scripture today?

Read James 1:21-25. How should we respond today when we hear the Word of God?

3. Prayer

Pray that God would speak to you through His Word and lead you to repentance.

Day 5

1. Scripture

Read 1 Kings 18:20-40

2. Reflection

What sin did the people of Israel need to repent from?

What false gods have you been following?

What was Elijah's prayer?

Why did Elijah offer this sacrifice?

What effect did this event have on the people of Israel? (see verse 39)

3. Prayer

Pray that God would reveal to you any false gods you have been following. Pray that God would be revealed to someone who does not believe during this series.

Day 6

1. Scripture

Read Isaiah 38:1-6

2. Reflection

What Word of God was given to Hezekiah?

What was Hezekiah's prayer?

On what grounds does Hezekiah base his prayer?

Why did God answer Hezekiah's prayer?

3. Prayer

Pray that God would enable you to walk before Him in truth, and that you might serve Him with your whole heart.

Day 7

1. Scripture

Read Psalm 119:1-8

2. Reflection

To what does the author of this Psalm attribute God's blessings?

Is it possible for any of us to be fully blameless before the Lord?

What does verse 4 mean and how should we live that out?

What was the Psalmist's response to God's word? (see verse 7)

What should we do when we see places in our lives where we are not keeping the commandments of the Lord?

3. Prayer

Pray verses 5-8. Read them if necessary, but try to memorize them. As you pray them, feel free to put them in your own words and apply them to your own life.
