Mark 1:16-18 (ESV) ¹⁶Passing alongside the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew the brother of Simon casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. ¹⁷And Jesus said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you become fishers of men." ¹⁸And immediately they left their nets and followed him.

1. Commit to _____.

Philippians 4:4 (Msg) Celebrate God all day, every day. I mean, revel in him!

Acts 2:46 (Msg) They followed a daily discipline of worship in the Temple followed by meals at home, every meal a celebration, exuberant and joyful,

Ephesians 4:25 (Msg) ...In Christ's body we're all connected to each other...

Hebrews 10:25 (NIV84) Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another-- and all the more as you see the Day approaching

3. Commit to _____.

Psalms 24:1 (NIV84) The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;

Matthew 6:31-33 (NIV84) So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Mark 10:28-30 (ESV) Peter began to say to him, "See, we have left everything and followed you." Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel, who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life.
