Last Words #3 - Pastor Gary Combs - March 12, 2017 - John 19:16-27

John 19:16-27 (ESV) ... ²⁶ When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to his mother, "Woman, behold, your son!" ²⁷ Then he said to the disciple, "Behold, your mother!" And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.

How to Know the Loving Care of Jesus:

1. Recognize His _____.

Mark 3:31-35 (ESV) And his mother and his brothers came, and standing outside they sent to him and called him. And a crowd was sitting around him, and they said to him, "Your mother and your brothers are outside, seeking you." And he answered them, "Who are my mother and my brothers?" And looking about at those who sat around him, he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers! For whoever does the will of God, he is my brother and sister and mother."

John 1:12 (ESV) But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God

2. Receive His _____.

Matthew 6:25-30 (ESV) "Therefore I tell you, do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink, nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air: they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. ...Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin, yet I tell you, even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass of the field, which today is alive and tomorrow is thrown into the oven, will he not much more clothe you, O you of little faith?"

1 Peter 5:7 (NLT) Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.

3. Accept His _____.

John 13:34 (ESV) A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another.

Ephesians 2:19 (NLT) So now you... are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God's holy people. You are members of God's family.
