Three Commitments to A Better Life

BETTER LIFE #1 - Pastor Gary Combs - August - Matthew 4:18-22

Matthew 4:18-22 (ESV) 18 While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. 19 And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." ²⁰ Immediately they left their nets and followed him. ²¹ And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. ²² Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

Three Commitments That Lead to A Better Life:
1. Commit to
Philippians 4:4 (Msg) Celebrate God all day, every day. I mean, revel in him!
Matthew 14:33 (ESV) And those in the boat worshiped him, saying, "Truly you are the Son of God."
2. Commit to
Ephesians 4:25 (Msg)In Christ's body we're all connected to each other
Hebrews 10:25 (NLT) And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especia now that the day of his return is drawing near.
Acts 5:42 (ESV) And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Chr is Jesus.
3. Commit to
Matthew 28:18-20 (ESV) ¹⁸ And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold I am with you always to the end of the age."

Acts 1:8 (ESV) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

Ephesians 2:8-10 (ESV) 8 For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
