

# To Faithfully Respond to Jesus

Resolved - January 3, 2020 - Hebrews 10:19-25

**Hebrews 10:19-25 (ESV)** <sup>19</sup> Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus, <sup>20</sup> by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh, <sup>21</sup> and since we have a great priest over the house of God, <sup>22</sup> let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. <sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup> And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, <sup>25</sup> not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

## Three Ways to Faithfully Respond to the Priestly Sacrifice of Jesus:

### 1. Draw near.

Hebrews 4:14-16; Hebrews 9:19-22; 2 Corinthians 3:4-6; Romans 8:38-39

### 2. Hold fast.

Romans 10:9; 1 Corinthians 1:9; 2 Timothy 2:13; 1 John 1:9; John 14:1-3; Hebrews 3:6

### 3. Stir up one another.

James 2:15-16; Hebrews 9:27-28; Acts 2:46-47; 3 John 1:14
